Conference

Supported by the Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Serbia, Association of Road Industry Employers "Putar" and the PE "Roads of Serbia" is organizing the First International Scientific and Expert Conference titled "Modern Road Maintenance", from November 7th to 9th, 2013 at the Izvor Hotel in Arandelovac, Serbia. The Conference is oriented towards road maintenance, rehabilitation, upgrade and expansion of the road network with the goal to stimulate economic recovery, growth promotion and support to social cohesion. The underlying idea is that the Conference should consider not only the region's crucial present needs for infrastructure, but also the future developmental needs.

Objective

Provision of stable source of financing which will enable the maintenance of I and II category state roads, preservation of their value and primarily the upgrade of traffic safety.

Special aspects

Regional cooperation for the delegations of the ministries will deal with the topics concerning the improvement of regional cooperation and traffic flow on border crossings. Expected results of the Conference are: higher degree of mutual understanding necessary for the upgrade on the regional level, higher efficiency regarding the coordination on global level, expansion of knowledge and positive experience in the region.
